**Clifton Springs Boat Harbour Entrance - Shallow Depth - Isolated Danger Mark**

**Date:** **Immediate.**

**Details:** Mariners are advised of the installation of a temporary Isolated Danger Mark Buoy at Clifton Springs Harbour Entrance to alert mariners of shallow depth due to a build-up of seaweed.

The buoy is at approximate location: 38°09.273'S, 144°33.198'E (WGS84) and with characteristics: Fl.(2) W.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when within the vicinity of Clifton Springs Boat Harbour Entrance.**
