**MAINTENANCE DREDGING WORKS**

**Date:** 27 November 2018.

**Details:** Mariners are advised that maintenance dredging works will take place from 28 November 2018 and continue until mid-April 2019. Dredging will take place at the following locations;

- Webb Dock
- Yarra River
- Swanson Dock
- Gellibrand Pier and Swing Basin
- Appleton Dock
- Victoria Dock
- Station Pier
- Holden Dock
- Maribyrnong
- 5 and 6 Yarraville

Works will commence with rock removal on the 28<sup>th</sup> of November at Webb Dock 1 East. Works will be conducted by Boskalis on a 24 hours / 7 days per week and be undertaken by BHD Storcken and the following associated plant:

- 2 x split hopper barges
- 1 x towage tug "Koto"
- 1 x crew transfer vessel (Investigator)
- 1 x sweep tug (Edi)

The program will be supported by the survey vessel John Norgate and Lonsdale.

All dredged material will be transferred to the Port of Melbourne Dredged Material Ground located in Port Phillip throughout the period of operation.
