Date: **Immediate.**

Details: Mariners are advised that the fixed port and starboard lateral mark lights within Victoria Harbour at the following approximate locations (WGS84) are non-operational:

Starboard lateral mark	Harbour entrance	No. 59	F.G	37°49.130'S	144°56.035'E
Port lateral mark	Harbour entrance	No. 60	F.R	37°49.076'S	144°56.003'E
Starboard lateral mark	Adjacent to Central Pier	No. 61	F.G	37°49.033'S	144°56.422'E
Port lateral mark	Adjacent to Central Pier	No. 62	F.R	37°49.078'S	144°56.447'E

The lights will be re-instated as soon as practicable.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of Victoria Harbour
